FOR THE 7TH CONSECUTIVE YEAR IN AUGUST 2007 HAA NEE NAA LODGE IS PROUD TO PRESENT PETER MORRISON. PETER IS A FORMER PROFESSIONAL ANGLING GUIDE AND A PIONEERING SALTWATER FLY ANGLER, MOST NOTABLY IN THE QUEST FOR PACIFIC SALMON. PETER IS CERTIFIED BY THE FEDERATION OF FLY FISHERS AS A MASTER CASTING INSTRUCTOR AND LOOKS FORWARD TO ENTERTAINING AUDIENCES WITH CASTING DEMONSTRATIONS AND SEMINARS. THE WORKSHOPS AND SEMINARS INCLUDED IN THIS SPECIAL PACKAGE WILL COVER MANY OF THE ASPECTS OF SALTWATER FLYFISHING ON THE PACIFIC NORTH COAST ENABLING YOU TO SUCCESSFULLY TARGET SILVER BRIGHT COHO SALMON AND A VARIETY OF OTHER SALTWATER SPECIES WHICH CAN BE TAKEN ON THE FLY. THE TRIP SCHEDULE WILL INCLUDE:

Day 1: WELCOME TO THE LODGE. INTRODUCTIONS, ORIENTATION, LUNCH, ROOM AND BOAT ASSIGNMENTS. PETER MORRISON WILL THEN GIVE HIS CREDENTIALS AND A BRIEF OVERVIEW OF WHAT TO EXPECT IN THE NEXT 4 DAYS. HE WILL DISCUSS THE BASICS AS FOR EQUIPMENT, CASTING AND FLIES USED IN CERTAIN CONDITIONS. CLAYTON VANIER, LODGE OWNER WILL THEN GIVE A THOROUGH DESCRIPTION OF THE BEST AREAS TO FISH, TIDE CONDITIONS, AND ANCHORING FUNDAMENTALS NEEDED TO FISH THESE WATERS. BREAK FOR DINNER AT 6 PM FOLLOWED BY A 45 MINUTE SLIDE SHOW GIVING A MORE DETAILED LOOK AT VARIOUS SCENARIOS AND APPROACHES, ALSO A MORE DETAILED LOOK AT FLIES, LEADERS AND EQUIPMENT. BACK ON WATER FOR THE NIGHT BITE, (OPTIONAL).

Day 2: UP BRIGHT AND EARLY TO CATCH THE EARLY MORNING BITE. PETER AND CLAYTON GOING OVER CERTAIN AREAS TO FISH IN GREATER DETAIL. QUESTION PERIOD WHERE GUESTS CAN ASK GUIDES ABOUT CERTAIN SCENARIOS, AREAS TO FISH, WHY, WHERE AND WHEN. PETER AND CLAYTON FISHING WITH ONE GUEST EACH FOR THE MORNING. LUNCH BREAK WITH A ONE HOUR SEMINAR DISCUSSING SPECIFIC SITUATIONS, CHART WORK AND HIGHLIGHTING

ON KNOT TYING AND FLY SELECTION. BACK OUT FISHING UNTIL DINNER AND THEN THE EVENING FISH. (OPTIONAL) EVENING ACTIVITY: REVIEW OF DAYS EVENTS AND STORY TELLING, POSSIBLE SUGGESTIONS FOR SUCCESS. HIGHLIGHT ON FLY TYING AND INSTRUCTION FOR UP TO 3 DIFFERENT FLY PATTERNS.

Day 3: UP EARLY AGAIN FOR THE MORNING BITE. LUNCH BREAK WITH ONE HOUR SEMINAR DISCUSSING THE MORNING EXPERIENCES. HIGHLIGHT ON CASTING SUITED TO ANGLER'S VARIOUS SKILL LEVELS. AFTER-NOON FISH FOCUSING ON ALTERNATE SPECIES TO CATCH ON THE FLY SUCH AS ROCKFISH AND LINGCOD. (OPTIONAL)

Day 4: FISH, FISH, FISH! EVENING ACTIVITY: REVIEW OF DAYS EVENTS AND TRIP HIGHLIGHTS AND WRAP UP!

ALL PARTICIPATING GUESTS WILL RECEIVE A FLYFISHING HANDBOOK, A CASTING TIP CARD WITH CASTING AIDS, AND A SMALL ASSORTMENT OF SALTWATER FLIES. PETER WILL BE AVAILABLE TO GIVE PROFESSIONAL CASTING INSTRUCTION TO ANY GUEST AT ANYTIME DURING THE TRIP SO THAT HE/SHE MAY BE ABLE TO

FULFILL THE MAXIMUM POTENTIAL OF THIS TRIP. THERE WILL ALSO BE LIMITED FREE GUIDING AVAILABLE THROUGHOUT THE TRIP.
